Short Summaries for each performance

Playgroup

The Playgroup sings *Kling Glöckchen Kling*, with handmade bells.

Preschool, Reception, Year 1

The hungry caterpillar, performed and sung by the Sturt Street Campus students.

Year 2 and Year 3

Year 2 and 3 perform the fairy tale of "the big fat pancake". As soon as the pancake finds out that he is going to get eaten, he decides to escape and wants to see the big wide world. He meets many animals who are keen to eat him as well. When he finally meets a pig, the story takes a turn. Will he get eaten? You will find out. Enjoy.

Year 4

The Golden Goose is a less-well known story from the Grimm Brother's compilation. Dumpling is so nicknamed by his family because they find him so foolish. He befriends an old man who is in fact magical. The old man gives him a goose made of gold. Anyone other than Dumpling who touches the goose becomes stuck to it so more and more curious passers-by become glued to one another. At this time lives a very sad princess who never laughs. Her father the king has proclaimed that he who makes his daughter laugh will marry her. When the princess sees Dumpling and all his hangers-on she cannot stop laughing. They marry and live happily ever after. Dumpling is never called Dumpling again, for he is not so foolish after all.

Year 5

Herr von Ribbeck auf Ribbeck im Havelland is a classical German poem, that is still very popular in Germany although it was written in 1887.

The poem tells of a member of the German lower nobility.

Von Ribbeck is described as gentle and generous; he often gives away pears from his pear-trees to children passing by. But he knows his son and heir to be a scrooge; so when von Ribbeck feels his end is near, he asks that a pear be put into his grave. This pear quickly grows into a pear-tree, which now provides free pears to the children, thus preserving the heritage of the late von Ribbeck.

Year 6/7

The year six class will show how Germans traditionally celebrate the Christmas period from the beginning of the advent to the Christmas evening in 4 scenes.

The first scene is about the importance of the advent wreath. The second scene explains St. Nikolaus evening on the 6th of December and the ritual attached to it. The third scene demonstrates Christmas market shopping and its traditional items and the last scene is about the celebration around the Christmas tree on the 24th of December.

Year 8

The cheerful classroom

A class is taught by a teacher who is asking his students many questions in a figurative sense. The kids answer them literally or give funny answers, which frustrates him very much. At the end he gives up and the kids frolic out of the classroom.

Year 9/10

Frau Parker's class is presenting three different interviews and one mini-play.
