Venues: Adelaide High School & Lyndoch Library

Learn German with highly qualified teachers at the School for the German Language Inc. Enjoy our vibrant community of German speakers and immerse yourself in the German language and culture. Our courses are designed to teach German language proficiency corresponding to the levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. This comprises oral communication skills, listening and reading comprehension and writing skills.

In 2018 we are offering classes for levels A1, A2 and B2. (New Beginners, Beginners Continuers, Continuers and Advanced).

Fees:

- Enrolment administration fee: \$30 (for first time enrolments only, no discounts)
- Course fee for 7 week course: \$245 (discounts apply)
- Course fee for 8 week course: \$280 (discounts apply)
- Course fee for 9 week course: \$315 (discounts apply)
- Course fee for 10 week course: \$350 (discounts apply)
