



## Rules for Construction of the School Calendar Each Year -- Issue 6

- (1) Our school classes operate only during mainstream (state) school terms; we start on the Saturday following the mainstream term start day and we finish the Saturday before the mainstream term finish day.
- (2) At Sturt Street the first day of Term 1 is enrolment and familiarisation day; school lessons start on the second Saturday.
- (3) Parent-Teacher meetings are generally scheduled in the middle of term 1.
- (4) The school Annual General Meeting is scheduled for mid-to-late March. The Parents & Friends Annual General Meeting is held on the same day.
- (5) Except for Easter, we operate as normal on any holiday weekends during term.
- (6) We generally finish each term with a cultural day/activity; viz. Easter/Harvest Festival, Lantern Parade, Family Fun Day, Xmas Concert; except that the Easter/Harvest Festival is held earlier if Easter occurs during Term 1.
- (7) There are no classes on the day of the Adelaide Christmas Pageant (the second Saturday in November unless that falls on Remembrance Day 11th November) but the school will be open for administration and meetings.
- (8) **There are no classes at Adelaide High if it is being used as a polling booth.**
- (9) Management Committee meetings are generally held on the second and second-to-last Saturday of each term, except that the first meeting of term 1 is held on the third Saturday.
- (10) A Review and Planning session is held on a Saturday afternoon near the end of Term 4.
- (11) A Teacher Professional Development day is held on the Saturday before the start of Term 2 or Term 3.
- (12) The school newsletter ("Wunderbar") is published near the beginning and end of each term.
